The Importance of Planning

The key to managing our money responsibly is planning. H. Stanley Judd wrote, “A good plan is like a road map: it shows the final destination and usually marks the best way to get there.” Just as we would never go on a long trip without a map, we should not try to manage our money without a plan. A common phrase puts it bluntly: “If you fail to plan, you plan to fail.”

Whether God gives you little or lots of money, you need to become a responsible planner. Planning enables you to accomplish more with the money that God entrusts to you. In Proverbs 16:3 we read: *“Commit to the Lord whatever you do, and your plans will succeed.”* Plan with confidence since God will always be with you to bless and watch over you. *“In his heart a man plans his course, but the Lord determines his steps”* (Proverbs 16:9).
