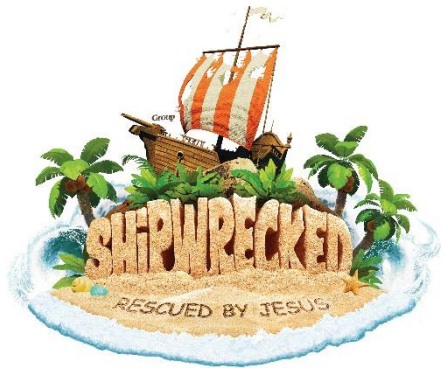
VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL
