

GUEST PREACHER


Pastor will be on vacation next week. Pastor Mike Poynter will be our guest preacher.

We are about to launch a social enterprise in Cincinnati. It is called Peace Café. Peace Café is a non-profit corporation, and is a three (3) pronged effort:

- The Peace Cafe is an eating establishment focusing on healthy, nutritious menu and, at the same time, providing an affordable breakfast & lunch menu to the Clifton area. Peace Café is strategically located directly next to the UC campus.

We are aiming to open the café in late August.

- Peace Café is also a job training/placement model, lifting up the homeless and poor, with an educational program in collaboration with Jobs Plus. Peace Café will provide on-the-job training. Jobs Plus will provide classroom training & job placement.

- Finally, Peace Café is a church plant. Peace Café is open as a café from 7am until 2pm, and closed on Sundays. During the evening hours and on Sunday, Peace Café is a church plant. Rev. Mike Poynter will hold Bible Study and Worship.
