At the last Voters' meeting the following resolution to amend/add to the Church constitution was submitted: and will act4d upon in the next Voters' Assembly on November 10.

ARTICLE XVI – Division (Schism)/Dissolution

A. If at any time a separation should take place in this congregation on account of doctrinal controversy, the property of the congregation and all the benefits there with shall remain with those members who shall continue to adhere to Articles II, IV, XI, XV of this constitution.

B. In the event that the congregation dissolves, all property shall be disposed of by the final voters assembly for the payment of debts and all just claims against the congregation, and any and all surplus and all rights connected therewith shall be donated to religious, charitable organizations, or 501(c)(3) organizations as determined by the final voters' assembly.
